

## Important information for Art Across the River artists

### REGISTRATION

- If you have already registered for the show and received a confirmation email, you are all set.
- If you plan to register for the show, please submit your registration as soon as possible. **Registration will close when we reach space limitations for the gallery, or at the end of the day on Wednesday, March 13 (11:59 PM), whichever is first.**

**Q:** Why are we imposing a deadline for submittals?

**A:** In order to be ready to receive your artwork at DROP OFF, we need your registration info several days in advance. ***NO walk-ins will be accepted.***

**REMINDER:** Payment at DROP OFF is **cash or check only**. ***We will not accept your work without payment of the entry fee.***

### VOLUNTEERING

Please consider volunteering to help with intake of artwork. This is primarily accepting artwork from arriving members, sorting and carrying their work to an area of the gallery where it will be hung at a later time.

### TRAVEL

Travel between PA and NJ is restricted by the Lambertville bridge construction project. Travel from Lambertville to New Hope is in one direction across the Free Bridge connecting Bridge Street in both towns. Return to NJ is over the 202Toll Bridge which is free.

This traffic pattern will be in effect for the DROP OFF date, Saturday March 16, through the duration of the exhibition.

New Hope has plenty of Pay-by-Plate Multispace Meters. Their kiosk system takes quarters, bills, credit cards, and parking apps [ParkMobile](#) and [PaybyPhone](#). There is a small public lot located behind the PNC Bank (near Starbucks), another medium-sized lot inside the Union Square Shops (where the Bucks County Children’s Museum and Triumph Brewing are) and on the south end of Main Street, up on the hill behind the Delaware Canal. Take a look at this helpful [map](#) (below) of all public kiosk parking. **New Hope Arts is located at Site 22 on the map, at the corner of Stockton and West Bridge streets. The medium-sized lot at Union Square Shops is the most convenient parking lot for New Hope Arts Center.**
